

EXAMINATIONS 2018

Specific Arrangements for Students with a Learning Difference, Disability or Injury

- ◆ A range of specific exams arrangements may be made for students who require provision due to a disability, learning difference or injury, such as standard additional time allowances for students with dyslexia, provision of computer for exams, services of an amanuensis (scribe), etc.
- ◆ For specific arrangements to be considered **you must provide supporting evidence** and send it to the Accessibility Services at FXPlus who will then make further arrangements with the Exams Office as appropriate.
- ◆ If you suffer from a permanent condition you will only be required to submit medical evidence **once** throughout your programme of study; specific provision for your examinations will be organised for the duration of your programme. Please **do** advise Accessibility Services of any changes in your condition.

You will receive notification by email of your specific provision with your exam room location when the main exams timetable is published. **Please contact the Examinations Office immediately if you have any queries about this.**

- ◆ Students with short-term injury may also request specific exam arrangements **directly from their college** providing this is supported by medical evidence.
- ◆ Students requesting further arrangements must first request an appointment with Accessibility Services.
