

EXAMINATIONS 2019

SPECIFIC PROVISION FOR STUDENTS WITH A LEARNING DIFFERENCE, DISABILITY OR INJURY

- ◆ A range of specific exams provisions are available for eligible students who require adjustments because of disability or injury. These provisions include extra time, computer use, a smaller room or the services of a scribe etc.
- ◆ Such arrangements can only be put in place after you have sent in **appropriate supporting evidence** and discussed your needs in an appointment with Accessibility Service at FXPlus who will then make further arrangements with the Exams Office as appropriate.
- ◆ If you have a long standing condition you will only be required to submit medical evidence **once** throughout your programme of study; specific provision for your examinations will be organised for the duration of your programme. Please **do** advise Accessibility Services of any changes in your condition.

You will receive notification by email of your specific provision and your exam room locations with your personal examination timetable. **Please contact the Examinations Office immediately on cc-exams@exeter.ac.uk or 01326 371815 if you have any queries regarding the provision.**

- ◆ Students with short-term injury may also request specific exam arrangements **directly from their college** provided this is supported by medical evidence.
- ◆ Students requesting further arrangements must request and attend an appointment with Accessibility Services by the following deadlines:

January exams	Friday 2nd November 2018
May exams	Friday 15th February 2019
Referred/Deferred exams	Friday 28th June 2019

If you do not make your request by this date it may not be possible to make further arrangements for your exams.
